11	Framework agreement between Police & NW to be signed off	Completed 1 <sup>st</sup> March 2024
<b>15</b> a	Improving contact between Coordinators, Safer Neighbourhood Teams and Community Safety Officers including Coordinator to Coordinator contact	Contact details are exchanged with SNTs as and when each coordinator gives their permission. Quality of the contact very much depends on local relationship building. We know we have senior officer support for this within the Met but more work is required on both sides. WhatsApp Communities trial is still running in three wards offering to connect coordinators with each other. The recent increase in the number of CSOs at the Council has meant an increased presence from them at our recruitment events and liaison has been exceptionally good with our dedicated NW contact Abbie Ball.
15b	Providing help to Coordinators on using the Alert system	No action to date pending some potential changes to the national database
15c	Guidance on finding ward level crime statistics	A short video was prepared but held back from release due to launch of a new Met IT system earlier in the year. This distorted some live reporting over the dual running period. It would not have been a good time to encourage users to look at the online data. We plan to review again this Autumn with the aim of making it available before the end of the year.
15d	Promoting NW as a means of building community relations not just crime prevention	Our Wandsworth-branded recruitment leaflets were designed specifically to focus on this.  We take every opportunity at community events to promote this aspect of NW
15e	Forming and developing our Association Committee	Numbers went from 3 to 7 by the end of the summer but there is more work to be done here – the Committee is too small to support our ambitions for the Association.
19	Could we find out if ourwatch.org.uk is likely to be developed into an App	This is likely but as yet we have no definite launch date.
20	Wandsworth specific window stickers were requested	The Committee decided to go with the standard version as the national network provide them free of charge but we have selected the modern branding – no police helmets or meerkats!
